The Four Incorporeal Creatures



Who are they

- Four living creatures in the midst and around the throne
- They are the Cherubs (Ezekiel 10:1)
- **Eze 10:1** And I looked, and behold! In the expanse over the head of the cherubs was seen the appearance of the form of a throne, like a sapphire stone, above them.
- God sits on them, this means God's find rest in them.
- God the limitless, is on a throne so they can be around Him
- The Church has a special feast for them



What do they look like

- Isaiah saw 4 faces for every creature
- John saw 1 face for every creature
- Each has 6 wings
- Wings covered with eyes

The Wings

- 6 Wings (3 pairs). Stands for speed in executing God's will and commandments
- First Pair: To cover the face, even the heavenly can not even see God in all His glory
- Second Pair: Cover their feet. Out of respect for God.
- Third Pair: to fly with. Execute God's will.



Eyes

- Full of Eyes
- Stands for knowledge



When did we hear about them

- Genesis 3:24, one man was exiled from Paradise
- Two statues were on the mercy-seat of the ark of covenant to remind people of Israel with God's presence and God's throne (Exo 25:17)
- The Devil was one of the Cherubim (Eze 28:14) (Knowledge is not sufficient).
